Test and Survey Results

From the Grade Center, you can view statistical information about your tests and surveys. For example, you can view what percentage of your students chose each multiple choice answer for one of your tests. Because surveys are ungraded, a check mark appears in the Grade Center cell for submitted surveys.

How to View Test or Survey Results

1. From the Grade Center, navigate to a test or survey's column.
2. Access the column's contextual menu and click Attempts Statistics.
