

In the Content area of the Course, click on Create Assignment module to create a Turnitin assignment.



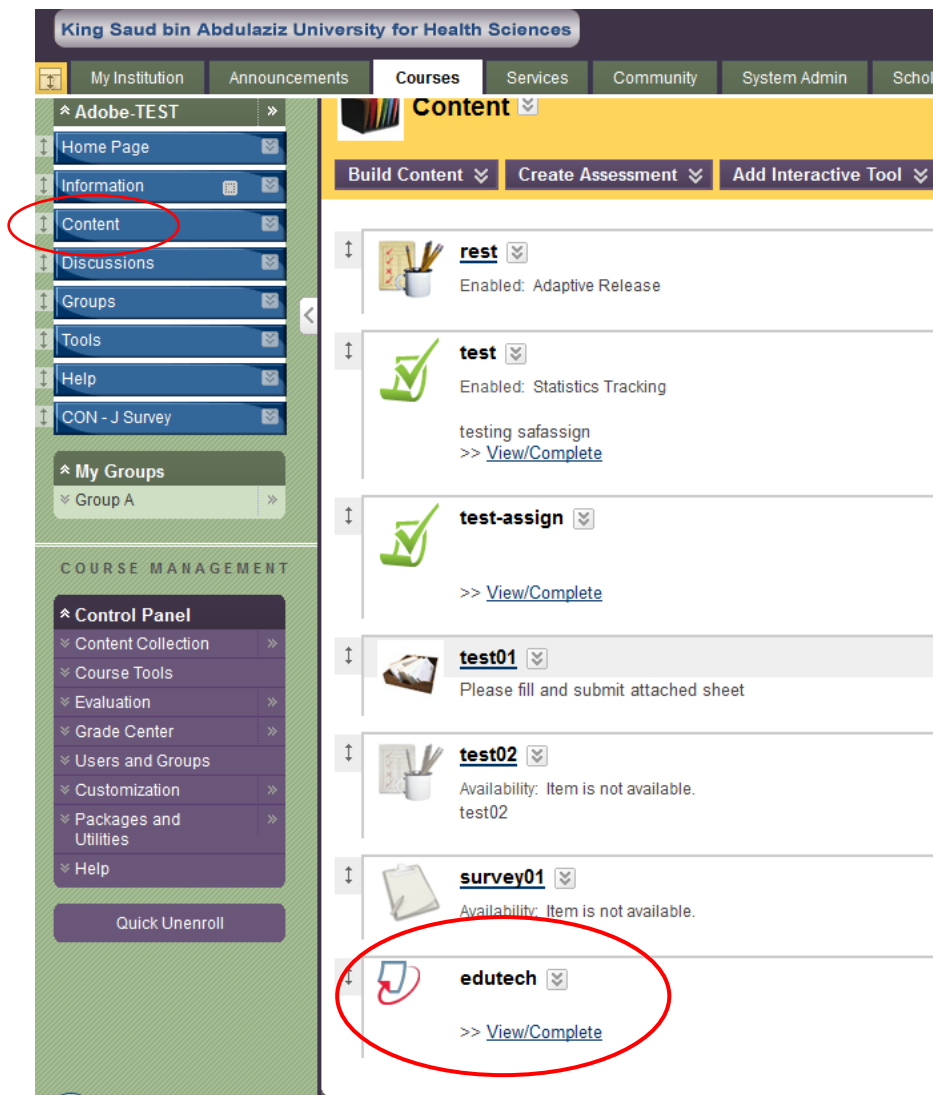
